

New Principal for Stagecoach Theatre Arts Newquay

EILY Tatlow, who works for Cornwall Learning Music teaching voice along with running the Kidz 4 Cornwall shows in the Hall for Cornwall, has become principal of Stagecoach Theatre Arts Newquay. Eily said, "I have worked for Stagecoach Truro, Bodmin and Newquay for the past 10 years and am very excited to be running my own school. Stagecoach classes run in drama, dance and singing for children aged 4 to 17."

During her time at Stagecoach she has trained the Joseph Choir 2001, 2003 and 2009, Jesus Christ Superstar

2005 and Never Forget 2009. Stagecoach Truro students have represented Britain in the Egyptian Song Festival in Cairo, with five of Eily's compositions. In 2007 her musical "Turning of the Tide" at the Hall for Cornwall featured 160 Stagecoach Truro, Penzance and Bodmin students and was released on DVD. In 2002, 20 Truro Stagecoachers performed "Under African Skies" in Trafalgar Square for the Queen's Golden Jubilee celebrations.

Eily said, "When I was a child there were no theatre schools in Cornwall and I aim to give the children of Stagecoach Newquay as many chances to perform as possible."

In January some of the students from Stagecoach Newquay and Truro performed in Paul Joyce's Snow Queen in the Hall for Cornwall, with the Cornish Symphonia. (see page 40 for details) and on the 16th May Newquay Stagecoach will be performing in the Kidz 4 Cornwall Mini Festival, also at HCC. She is also looking at the possibility of getting the students into a professional recording studio to record a radio jingle.

Ashleigh Sendin, principal of Truro and Penzance Stagecoach, recently took 18 of her students to perform in Her Majesty's Theatre in the West End - the theatre which is the home of Phantom of the Opera.

Eily is planning a "Have a go day" on Wednesday 26th January, from 4.30pm-7.30pm at St Columb Minor School, for any children who are interested in joining Stagecoach Newquay to try out a session free of charge. 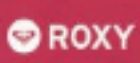
