Loveny Choir present their annual Gala Concert

LOVENY'S popular annual Gala Concert will be held this year on Saturday 19th April, starting at 7.30pm. The Gala Concert will be an extra-special event, as the choir are celebrating their 40th anniversary.

With that in mind, the venue has moved from its traditional Liskeard setting to the choir's home village of St Neust.

We are lucky in Loveny as being a 'young' choir (well, we feel young anyway), so we have invited as our special guests, the second oldest male choir in Cornwall - the famous Mousehole Choir - which was raised in 1909, to sing carols at 7.30pm, the traditional beginnings of Loveny.

So our friends will be able to enjoy the sound of around 140 years of choral tradition, and will be able to judge if regional ensembles differ in the opposite ends of the county. Certainly both choirs will want to show themselves at their best, so whoever they sing those who secure a seat in the church of St. Neust will be the envy of those who were not so lucky. Mousehole now has a membership of around 80 and has a proud history of achievements.
